Health and Safety

Bauer Technologies has both statutory and moral responsibilities to provide the highest standards of health and safety protection for its staff and for other people who may be affected by our activities. Bauer Technologies management team are committed to continually improving our health and safety management, systems and performance.

This policy applies in respect of any activity undertaken by Bauer Technologies. It should be read in conjunction with our arrangements documents which describe the methods of implementing these principles.

We aim to:

- prevent accidents, so far as reasonably practicable, before they occur
- maintain the Health and Safety of our personnel and others affected by our activities.
- subject the way we work to constant, critical review in order to ensure that we are continually looking to improve.
- ensure that our activities are compliant with relevant legislative and other applicable requirements

In order to meet these aims we shall:

- Identify the hazards associated with our activities and remove the risks where practicable
- Provide an environment in which our employees can work safely, and which is safe for third parties by controlling those risks which cannot be removed
- Provide the necessary resource to implement our policies and procedures
- Monitor our performance by means of setting objectives and targets, charge management with reviewing and improving these
- Keep up to date with best practice and comply with all relevant legislation, authoritative guidance and other applicable requirements
- Ensure those who undertake work on our behalf apply the same standards of health and safety as we do
- Co-operate actively with local authorities, statutory bodies, other public services and any other relevant stakeholders in the interests of ensuring public safety
- Ensure that the health and safety of our operation is seen and maintained as a significant priority
- Consult with, and involve our staff in health and safety matters
- Provide the correct equipment, materials and plant
- Provide training, instruction and information to employees to increase competence and raise awareness
- Bring the contents of this policy to the attention of all employees and make it available, where requested to interested parties

We require the full and active participation of all our employees in order that the principles outlined in this policy statement can be achieved. Statutory duties should only ever be perceived as minimum standards and we aim to achieve best practice in all that we do.
